

All-Local Farmers' Market
Guidelines for Specialty Food Products and Non-Farm Crafts
Columbia, SC

All Specialty food products and non-farm crafts must be approved by the Market Manager and Specialty Product Review Committee prior to selling at the Columbia All-Local Farmers' Market. The purpose of this process is to maintain the highest quality specialty products and non-farm crafts at the market. Specialty products and non-farm crafts must exhibit an appreciation of the craft and the artistry of its production.

Specialty food products and non-farm crafts include those items that are produced from materials **not** grown or gathered by the specialty food product/craft person.

All persons interested in selling a specialty food product or non-farm craft must follow these steps for approval:

1. Submit a vendor application for the Columbia All-Local Farmers' Market to the Market Manager.
2. Read the All-Local Farmers' Market Rules & Guidelines, as well as the Guidelines for Specialty Food Products and Non-Farm Crafts.
3. Upon request, submit samples and photos of the specialty food product or non-farm craft to the Market Manager and Specialty Product Review Committee for final approval.
